



The JRA in partnership with SANRAL in Construction of Eastbound overpass Bridge on Le Roux Avenue in Region A – Midrand- Halfway House Ext. 37

The Johannesburg Road Agency (JRA) has entered into a service level agreement Contract with South African National Roads Agency Limited (SANRAL) for SANRAL to Implement the erection of an overpass bridge on Le Roux Avenue in Midrand on behalf of the JRA.

The location of the Project is taking place in Region A Halfway House Ext 37- Midrand in Bekker Street and Le Roux Avenue. The bridge overpasses the N1 High Way. The Service Level Agreement has been agreed upon by both parties. The name of the Consultant is Aecom Consultants and the main appointed contractor is Civilcon Pele Kaofela JV.

It was thought that SANRAL, due to its expertise in implementation of bridges, are suitable for the implementation of the project instead of having JRA to implement the project. The project is estimated to be implemented for R 40 511 749.81 over a period of 2 years. The summarized progress to date is that footings have been installed. Columns have been erected and the Beams were loaded on the 18 of October and the anticipated completion date is April 2014.

A payment of R 15 Million has been effected to SANRAL this is an advance payment that has been transacted into the account of South African National Roads Agency Limited (SANRAL) for implementation of the project on behalf of the Johannesburg Road Agency. The following SMME's are employed on site for the project: Mississippi Construction Steel Fixing; Reasebetsa Security Services; Phobetja Trading Enterprise Steel Fixing and Thaha Construction Tipper Hire.
