Traffic Advisory: One Way Dual Carriageway Visual Inspection

Johannesburg Roads Agency (JRA) will be carrying out a visual inspection on Main Reef Road from Production Road to Church Street onto the M2 Motorway towards the City Centre as part of its M2/ Main Reef and Linked Extensions Upgrade.

**Partial lane closures will be carried out during the inspection activities on:
Saturday, 07 October 2017 from 09:30 – 15:00**

Affected Routes:

1. From Production and Church Roads
2. M2 Motorway from Treu Overpass Bridge on the far right lane towards Main Reef

Motorist are advised to consider alternative routes on 07 October. Those travelling on the affected route are requested to:

- Travel at a safe distance upon entry into the construction area
- Travel at reduced speeds
- Be aware of men at work on site.

Traffic Management Plan

1. Only one lane will be affected at a time.
2. Flagmen will be positioned at intervals to warn motorists that they are approaching a construction site. Flagmen will face oncoming traffic and will move along with the truck.
3. A traffic safety officer will be on site together with a guide construction vehicle operator.
4. Support vehicles will travel on site, heavily equipped with High Visibility Rear Panel including two flash lights
5. Temporary roads signage has been installed along the construction route indicating Men at Work, speed limits, chevrons and directional arrows, road reduced to one lane.
