OPENING OF M2 MOTORWAY

The Executive Mayor of the City of Johannesburg, Cllr Herman Mashaba and the Member of the Mayoral Committee (MMC) for Transport, Cllr Nonhlanhla Makhuba, will be having a ceremony to mark the completion of the M2 Motorway on the 30th October 2019. Traffic will be accommodated on the Motorway from the 4th November 2019.

The Johannesburg Roads Agency (JRA) closed the M2 Motorway between Crown Interchange and Maritzburg Streets on the 28th February 2019 for rehabilitation. The closure was necessitated by the continuous monitoring and the bridge visual conditions assessment which indicated that the structural integrity of the concrete elements was severely reduced.

The opening will be a relief to motorists as many had to endure heavy traffic volumes daily. The JRA would like to thank all motorists and road users who were inconvenienced by the closure, for their patience during this period.
