## **Traffic Advisory Press Street/ Main Reef/ M2 Onramp Slip Lane Intersection Rehabilitation**

Motorists are advised to consider alternative routes at the weekend, 03-04 March 2018, as **Johannesburg Roads Agency (JRA)** embarks on rehabilitation of the layer work on Main Reef Road at Press Street and the M2 onramp intersection. Construction commenced in early February and forms part of the City's R30 million upgrade of the M2 – Main Reef interchange to decrease congestion and improve access.

### **Temporary Road Closures:**

- Saturday, 03 March 2018 from 08:00 – 18:00

### **Affected Routes:**

1. Press Street northbound towards Main Reef Road.
2. M1N/M2EB onramp eastbound from Main Reef Road in both directions.
3. Main Reef westbound and eastbound between M2 West Rand off-ramp and Church/Crownwood Road.

### **Motorists travelling along these affected routes are also advised to:**

- Follow detour signs on site
- Travel at a safe distance upon entry into the construction area
- Travel at reduced speeds
- be aware of men at work in the work zone and
- Adhere to traffic guidelines, flag persons and signage such as road fragments.
