TRAFFIC ADVISORY

M2 Main Reef Asphalt Surfacing on 8 - 10 December 2017

Motorists are advised to consider alternative routes from 08 – 10 December, as the **Johannesburg Roads Agency (JRA)** carries out asphalt surfacing along Main Reef Road. The roadworks form part of the City's R30 million upgrade of the M2 – Main Reef interchange to decrease congestion and improve access. Throughout the construction period, heavy congestion is expected in and around China Mall, M2, Main Reef and Treu Road. Traffic on the M2 southbound towards the City will not be affected.

Challenges Posed by Inclement Weather

Heavy rainfall experienced during the week may lead to the postponement of works, as the laying of asphalt is dependent on special temperature requirements.

Partial Lane Closure on the R41 and M2:

- Lane reductions can be expected in the afternoons.
- Temporary road closures will occur on the M2 onramp as well as the R41 where two lanes will be completely closed.

Detours:

- 1) Traffic from Park Street turning into Main Reef southbound will proceed across and use the detour route.
- 2) Traffic travelling from City side will turn into Treu Road and use the detour route.

Precautionary Measures:

Motorists travelling in the vicinity and along the affected route are requested to:

- Travel at a safe distance upon entry into the construction area
- Travel at reduced speeds, be aware of construction workers on site
- Adhere to traffic guidelines, flag people and signage.
