Traffic Advisory

Press Street/ Main Reef/ M2 Onramp Rehabilitation

Motorists are advised to consider alternative routes on **10 February 2018**, as **Johannesburg Roads Agency (JRA)** will embark on road rehabilitation on Main Reef Road at Press Street and the M2 onramp intersection. The development forms part of the City's R30 million upgrade of the M2 – Main Reef interchange to decrease congestion and improve access.

Temporary Road Closures:

- Road closures will be implemented on Saturday, 10 February 2018 from 08:00 – 18:00.

Affected Routes:

1. Press Street North bound towards Main Reef Road.
2. M1N/M2E onramp eastbound from Main Reef Road in both directions.
3. Main Reef westbound and eastbound between M2 West Rand offramp and Church/Crownwood Road.

Motorists travelling along the affected routes are advised to consider alternative routes or:

- Follow detour signs
- Travel at a safe distance upon entry into the construction area
- Travel at reduced speeds, be aware of men at work on site
- Adhere to traffic guidelines, flag persons and signage.
