MTIPA ROAD CONSTRUCTION AT ITS COMPLETION STAGE



Mtipa Road in Orlando West, Ward 39 has been closed to traffic since the 10th April 2012. The main reason for the closure was the rehabilitation of culverts, lowering the water table in the area, as well as improving the stormwater flow across the street, thus preventing damage to the road in future.

It was anticipated that the project will be complete by the end of June but due to difficult ground conditions experienced by the contractor the project was thus delayed. Water had to be pumped out each morning before construction commences.

The construction of this road is in line with the Joburg 2040 Growth and Development Strategy (GDS) vision which commits to a World Class African City as a liveable City, providing safe, walkable, exciting and interesting neighbourhoods; a City that provides sustainability for all citizens and a resilient and adoptive society.

JRA can proudly say that the road is in its completion stage and it is envisaged that it will be ready for traffic by the end of August 2012.
