NDLOVU BRIDGE OVER RAILWAY IN DUBE (SOWETO) TEMPORARILY CLOSED

The Johannesburg Roads Agency (JRA) has received concerns regarding the safety of the Ndlovu Bridge in Dube. An inspection to determine the condition of the structure was carried out on the 17th of March 2021 and concluded that the bridge approaches are washing away. This is caused by the heavy rainfalls.

It was also noted this does not pose an immediate danger, however, the JRA has seen fit to make immediate interventions and prepare for the rehabilitation of the support structure of the bridge, in light of the finalised report received from the road experts.

The JRA has decided to temporarily close off the bridge as a precautionary measure. In the meantime, emergency repairs will be conducted on the bridge while plans for a long-term solution are being made.

Road users are advised to use alternative routes. Further developments regarding the Ndlovu bridge will be communicated in due time.
