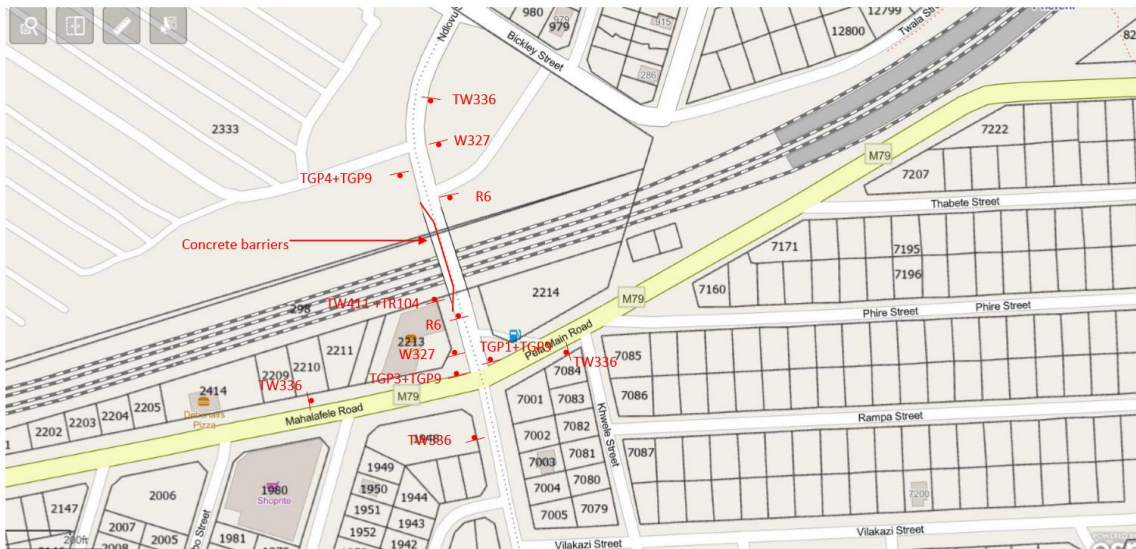

### UPDATE ON THE NDLOVU BRIDGE TEMPORARY CLOSURE

The Johannesburg Roads Agency (JRA) has implemented a partial closure on the Ndlovu Bridge.

Further developments in the investigations pertaining to the bridge indicated that only a sectional closure of the affected lane is required. The northbound traffic lane on the Ndlovu Bridge over the railway (between Mahalefele Road and Bickley Street in Dube) has been temporarily closed, as a precautionary measure. In the meantime, emergency repairs will be conducted while plans for long-term repair solutions are being made. Pedestrian access along the bridge remains unaffected.

The JRA will provide an update on the developments concerning the Ndlovu Bridge and would like to thank road users for their patience.
