TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURE OF VILLAGE ROAD BETWEEN NTEMI PILISO STREET AND USSHER STREET.

The Johannesburg Roads Agency (JRA) will be temporarily closing one lane along Village Road between Ntemi Piliso Street and Ussher Street. Traffic from M2 Selby off-ramp will be impacted. The lane closure is necessitated by propping of the deck for construction. **The closure will be applicable from the 23rd August 2019 until 28th October 2019.**

JMPD will be assisting with points duty during morning peak and afternoon peak hour. JRA is calling on motorists to exercise caution and reduce their speed upon entering the lane closure area.
