NOTICE: Traffic Diversion on Wemmer Pan (M11) following a Temporary Road Closure

The Johannesburg Roads Agency (JRA) wishes to notify motorists travelling along Wemmer Pan Road (M11), between Reynolds Street and Turf Siding Road, of a route diversion plan implemented to accommodate traffic following a temporary sectional closure in the area.

The sectional closure on Wemmer Pan Road is due to safety risks associated with sinkholes caused by illegal mining activities. The JRA has provided the following diversion route:

- Motorists leaving the Johannesburg CBD, travelling in a southerly direction along Wemmer Pan should turn right at the Reynolds Street intersection, followed by an immediate left turn at the intersection of Rosettenville Road and Fennel Street. Motorists should thereafter proceed southwards along Rosettenville Road until the intersection with Turf Siding Road where they will be able to join Wemmer Pan Road again.
- Motorists travelling from the Turffontein suburb, in a northerly direction along Wemmer Pan Road, should turn left at the Turf Siding Road intersection, followed by an immediate right turn at the intersection of Rosettenville Road. They are to continue northwards along Rosettenville Road until the intersection with Fennel Street where they will be able to join Wemmer Pan Road again.
- Alternatively, drivers can avoid Wemmer Pan Road by making use of Turf Siding Road and Rosettenville Road as an alternative route to travel between Turffontein and Johannesburg CBD.

Remedial work to Wemmer Pan Road is currently at a planning stage. Further updates will be communicated on when construction work will commence.

Motorists are urged to approach Wemmer Pan Road with caution, especially when travelling at night. The JRA apologises for the inconvenience caused and would like to thank motorists in advance for their patience and co-operation.
